Day 1

- Arrival at your accommodation and dinner.

Day 2

- After breakfast we set out towards the Orellana Reservoir, stopping at the archaeological site of Lacimurga, on Cogolludo hill, to spot birds such as the Common Teal, Mallard, Northern Shoveler, Great Crested Grebe, Great Cormorant, Grey Heron, Black Stork, Egyptian Vulture, Griffon Vulture, Golden Eagle or Bonelli's Eagle.
- Lunch on your own.
- Visit to the wetland area of Zújar Reservoir to see wetland and steppe bird species.
- Return to your rural accommodation and dinner.



Day 3

- After breakfast we set out towards the town of Casas de Don Pedro, stopping at Azud viewpoint to see species such as the Gadwall, Mallard, Great Crested Grebe, Grey Heron, Eurasian Spoonbill, Green and Common Sandpiper, etc.
- Visit to Puerto Peña. Watch the colony of Griffon Vulture and the other remaining species in the area such as the Egyptian Vulture, Black Stork. Visit the Centre of Rock-dwelling Fauna of Puerto Peña.
- Lunch on your own.
- Visit to Herrera del Duque, going up to the castle to watch bird species such as the Red-rumped Swallow, Blue Rock Thrush or the Common House Martin.
- Return to your rural accommodation and dinner.



Day 4

- After breakfast we set out towards Cijara Reservoir, stopping in the towns of Villarta and Bohonal de los Montes. We go birdwatching around the network of viewpoints and hides in the area, with important species including the Black Kite, Griffon Vulture, Eurasian Black Vulture, Golden Eagle, Eurasian Jay, etc.
- Lunch on your own.
- We visit the town of Helechosa de los Montes for more birdwatching.
- Return to your rural accommodation and dinner.



Day 5

- After breakfast we go up to the castle of Puebla de Alcocer, with beautiful scenery, to go birdwatching.
- Tour around the historical quarter of Puebla de Alcocer, visiting the Ethnographic Museum and the Convent de la Visitación to watch the colony of White Stork and Lesser Kestrel.
- Stop at Masatrigo hill, which has a spectacular conical shape, to spot wetland and steppe bird species.
- Lunch on your own.
- Visit to the castle of Capilla, at the end of La Serena Reservoir, to watch wetland and Mediterranean mountain bird species.
- Visit Octava del Corpus Museum in Peñalsordo.

- Return to your rural accommodation and dinner.

Day 6

- After breakfast we set out to the dam of La Serena Reservoir to watch wetland birds such as Great Cormorant, Grey Heron, Mallard, Northern Pintail, etc.
- Next we drive along the road known as La Golondrina (the swallow), one of the best areas in the Iberian Peninsula for spotting steppe species, such as the Great and Little Bustard, Black-bellied Sandgrouse or Montagu's Harrier.
- Lunch on your own.
- Visit the Centre for the Interpretation of Rock Art (third millennium before Christ) in the town of Cabeza del Buey.
- Visit the castle of Almorchón and the chapel of Belén, both of which belonged to the Knights Templar, next to the Sierra de Tiro, to watch bird species such as the Griffon Vulture or Golden Eagle.
- (Sightings of Crane in winter).
- Return to your rural accommodation and dinner.

Day 7

Breakfast and return journey.

Includes

- 6 nights half-board in rural accommodation.
- Specialized guides and transportation.
- Language services on the excursions: English and German.
- Airport transfers (from Madrid or Seville). In/out.
- Binoculars, telescope, bird guides.
- Entrance to monuments.
